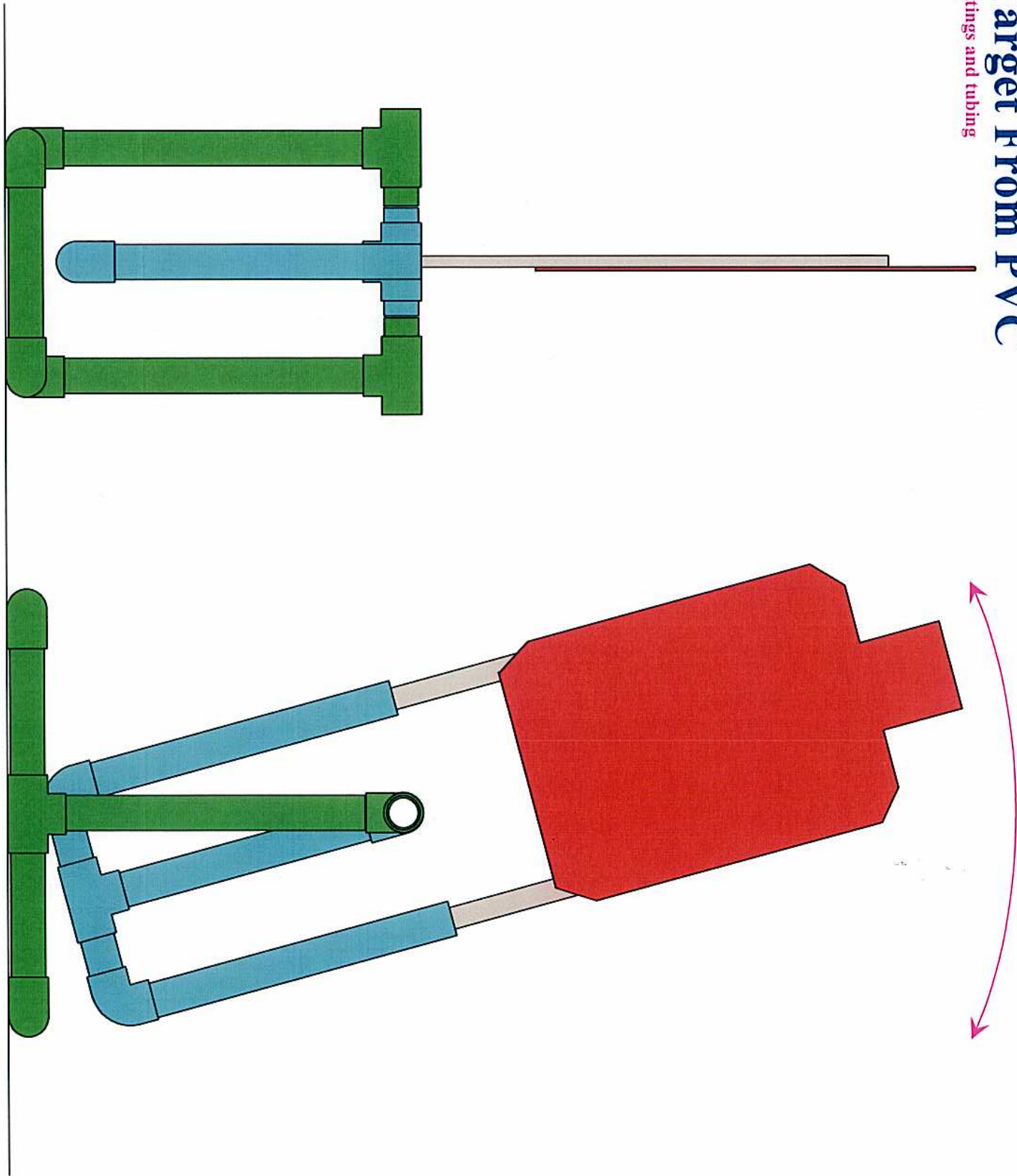


Rocking Target From PVC

Made from 2" PVC fittings and tubing



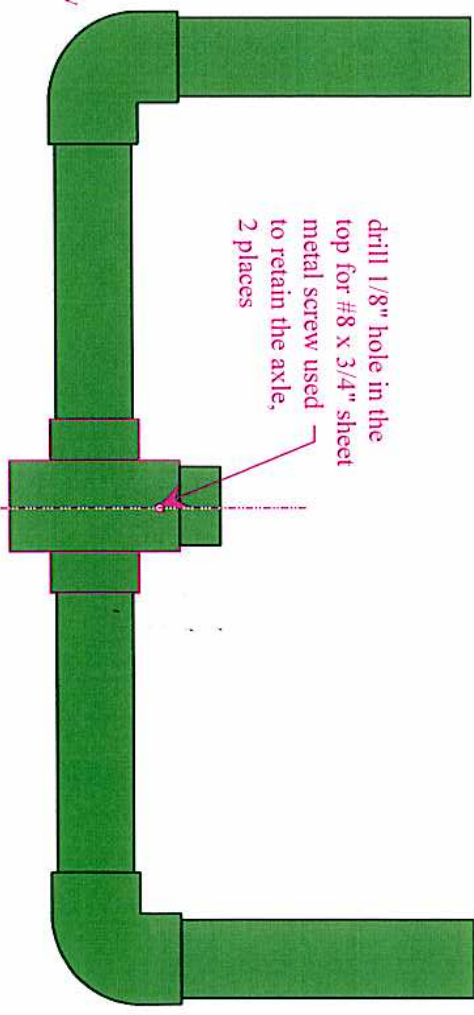
Rocking Target From PVC

Base Assembly. make from 10' of 2" PVC, 4 Ts and 4 elbows

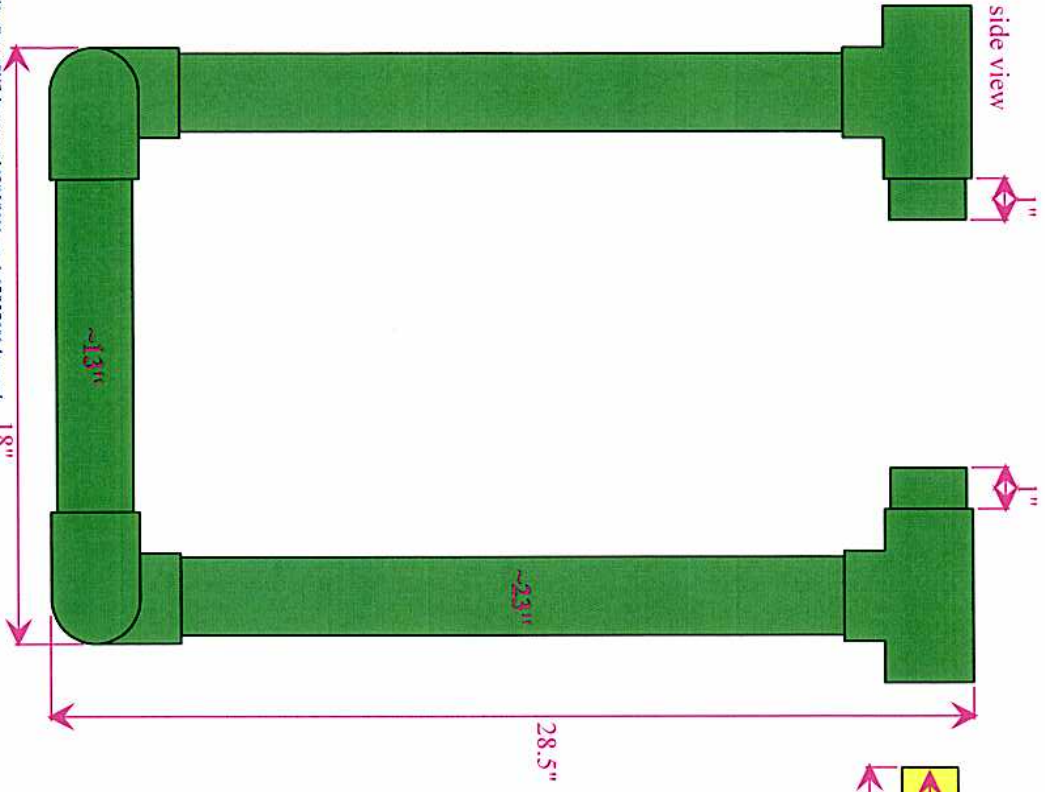
Assembly Tips:

Typically, PVC tubing is glued together which makes a very good target stand. However it also makes the target stand very hard to repair. An alternative is to press the PVC fittings and pipe together and fasten the joints with #8 x 1/2" metal screws. If a repair is needed, a new part can be substituted for the broken one in a few minutes. A supply of fittings and pipe, a screw driver and a small hand saw is all that is needed to make repairs at the range.

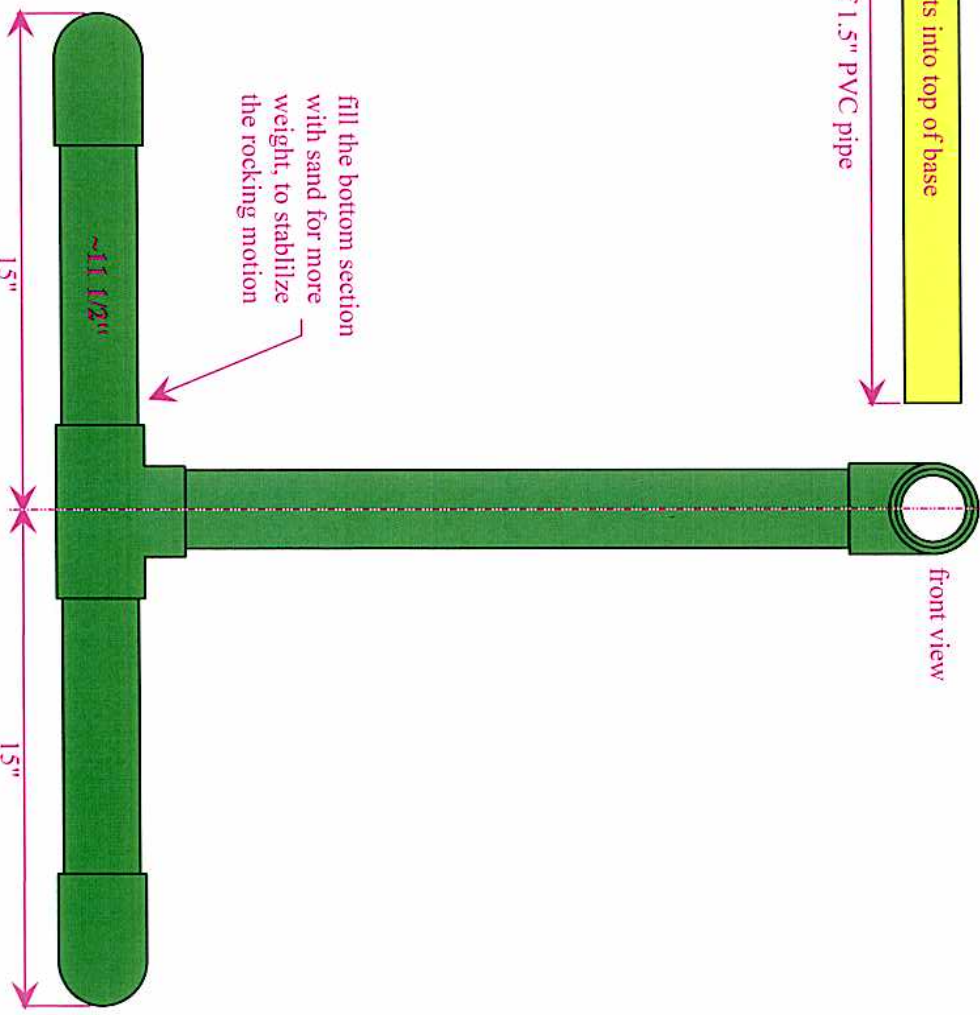
1/2 of top view



side view

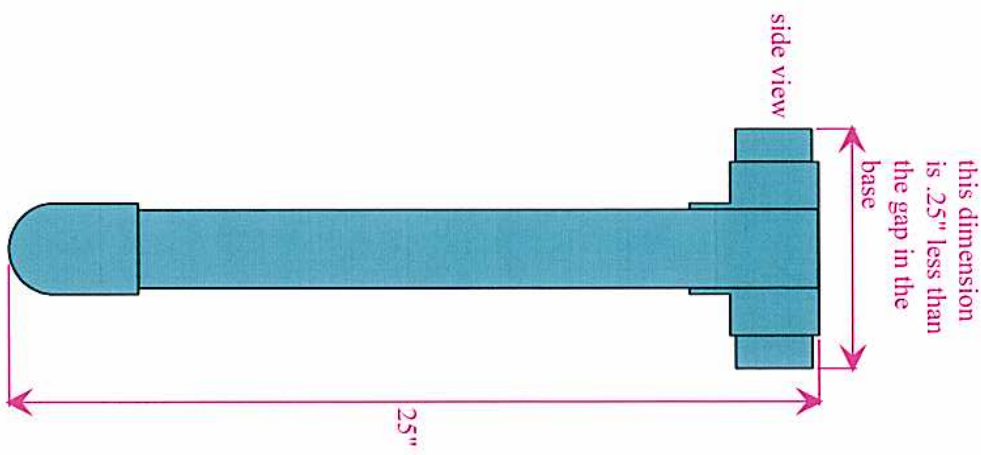


front view

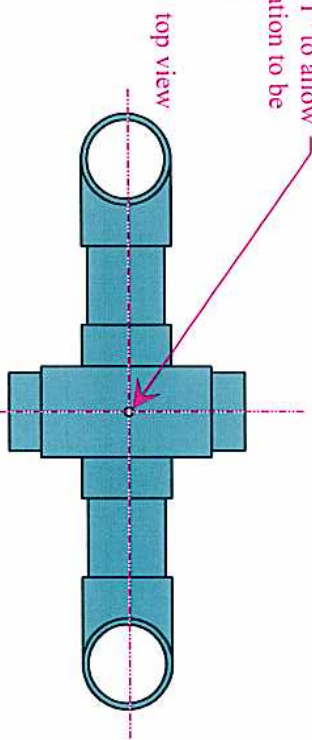


Rocking Target From PVC

Rocking Assembly, make from 10' of 2" PVC, 2 T's and 2 elbows



drill 1/8" hole in the top of the PVC "T" to allow lubrication to be added



fill the bottom section with sand for more weight, to facilitate the rocking motion
more sand equals a slower rocking motion
